- 2. The applicant **must** register for a minimum 12 credits per semester beginning the 1st fall after high school graduation. ** If you are applying for a technical or trade school scholarship, please refer to the Technology/Trade Scholarship Application. **
- 3. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average as listed on the Scholarship Summary Description. The Scholarship Committee may waive the GPA requirement upon documentation of special circumstances.
- 4. Complete a Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Application, complete the required essay and resume, and submit required supporting documentation as listed on the application.

The Scholarship Committee shall be composed of members of the Harford County Chambers of Commerce and sponsor representatives. The Scholarship Committee will select the award recipients. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to award the scholarship to the most overall qualified applicant based on any or all of the selection criteria. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
