- Please include a one-page typed resume that includes your work experience and any awards or recognition you
  have received.
- Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from people who have known you for at least one year and who are not related to you. If you are a current high school student submitting an application for the Technology/Trade category, one of your signed letters should come from a teacher.

The Scholarship Committee shall be composed of members of the Harford County Chambers of Commerce and sponsor representatives. The Scholarship Committee will select the award recipients. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to award the scholarship to the most overall qualified applicant based on any or all the selection criteria.
